The SA Forum has been very active in 2007, and we plan to deliver exciting developments throughout the second half of the year. We've already launched our self-guided training materials. These downloadable tutorials allow users to train themselves on SA Forum specs from the comfort of their own desk, at their own pace, and on their own schedule. We are also committed to keeping our specifications up-to-date, relevant, and accessible to the industry.

As I have mentioned in the past, SA Forum Hardware Platform Interface (HPI) has been an impressive market success with many platform vendors providing HPI services as part of their platforms, and many Independent Software Vendors (ISVs) are providing service availability middleware that utilizes such services. Building on this success, I believe 2007 will be a turning point for AIS (Application Interface Specification) with multiple implementations of the most recent specifications, setting the stage for wider adoption of this important standard by the industry in the months to come. As I speak with potential users and providers of software developed to comply with AIS standard, the question is no longer "tell me about AIS", but more like "tell me about AIS product roadmap and compliant product plans."

The industry's interest in SA Forum and its interfaces is ever increasing. This is exemplified by new members joining to the Forum. Most recently, we announced the addition of two new members (read more about them below), and will soon be announcing the availability of our first compliance test suite. SA Forum members will be participating in several upcoming events and we hope you'll visit us at the events listed below. We also plan to release updated specifications this fall, and encourage you to join us in the development of these specifications.
